Replacing Batteries

Tool required - Small Phillips head screwdriver.

- 1. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, loosen the screw in the battery cover and remove the cover.
- 2. Install two fresh AAA/LR03 batteries as indicated in the battery compartment.
- 3. Replace battery cover and tighten screw.



Parts included:

- 1 Blaster
- 3 Light-up Fireballs





To turn on the Fireball light, firmly press the ball on the opposite side of where the light is. Remember to press again to turn off when not in use to conserve battery life.

Push the Fireballs into the launch tube.

Extend the firing tube to its maximum length. Then, quickly pull the firing tube back to launch Fireball. The faster you pull back, the farther the Fireballs will fly.
