


My Fellow Explorer,

As night falls, lighting a safe path on wooded trails or on the way back to home base is vital. Your new Expedition Shoe Lights are a valuable asset, allowing you to light the way without a flashlight, keeping your hands free for other important tasks.

Start exploring with the activities described below, or use your imagination to think of your very own, games and adventures!

IMPORTANT! Shoe Lights are not waterproof. So don't get them wet!





Tool required — small Phillips-head screw driver

- 1. Using a Phillips-head screwdriver,
- 3. Replace the battery compartment cover. Do not over-tighten scre



NIGHT CRITTER HUNT

Find out what critters are crawling around your backyard at night! Fasten on and illuminate your Shoe Lights, then, with a parent, slowly walk through your yard at night. Carefully observe the ground and see what creatures come out to greet you! Keep a record of what you see.

RATTERY SAFETY INFORMATIO

- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision
- Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed
- Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity
 Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited
- Do not mix old and new batteries
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable(nickel-cadmium) batteries
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire. Battery may explode or leak.

RED VERSUS WHITE!

This outdoor, nighttime game turns you and a friend into the playing Pieces! Ask a parent to prepare 11 fun questions about nature and science. Attach one Shoe Light to your shoe and one to a friend's. Turn them on and adjust them so one light, glows white and the other red. Head outside and have your parent ask the prepared questions. Whoever answers correctly takes a step forward and scores a point. After all the questions are asked, the player with the most points wins!
