


EXPEDITION KING PACK

My Fellow Explorer, Your new Expedition Trekking Pack will keep all of your gear and essentials organized and accessible when exploring in the field, allowing you to take advantage of the unexpected at a moment's notice. Always make sure to carry water and snacks, along with the proper gear to explore the world around you!

Start exploring with the activities described below, or use your imagination to think of your very own games and adventures!



GEAR UP AND EXPLORE!

Ready to go on an amazing expedition? First, make sure you have all of your important exploration, gear stored in your Expedition Trekking Pack. Use the compass on the 4-in-1 Explorer Navigation Tool to head off in a specific direction. When you spot a critter or leaf that looks interesting, pull out the 3-in-1 Expedition Magnifier and take a look! If you want to inspect it later, pick it up with the All-Terrain Nature Collector and

drop it into the High Sierra Eco-Explorer for safe keeping. If you find something bigger that you can't pack up, tag it with one of the balls from Earth Tag! When you locate a place where you want others to join you, set off the Expedition Sky Flare to let them know where you are. As the sun begins to set and you head for home, turn on the Deep Cave Explorer Echo Maker searchlight and your Expedition Shoe Lights to light your way.

MASTER COLLECTOR

Bring a few small, sealable plastic specimen bags with you the next time you go out exploring. Pick a collecting theme for the day—it could be rocks and minerals one trip, tree leaves on another.

Collect your finds and place them in the specimen bags, then store them in the large pocket on your Trekking Pack. What amazing finds did you come back with to start your collection?
